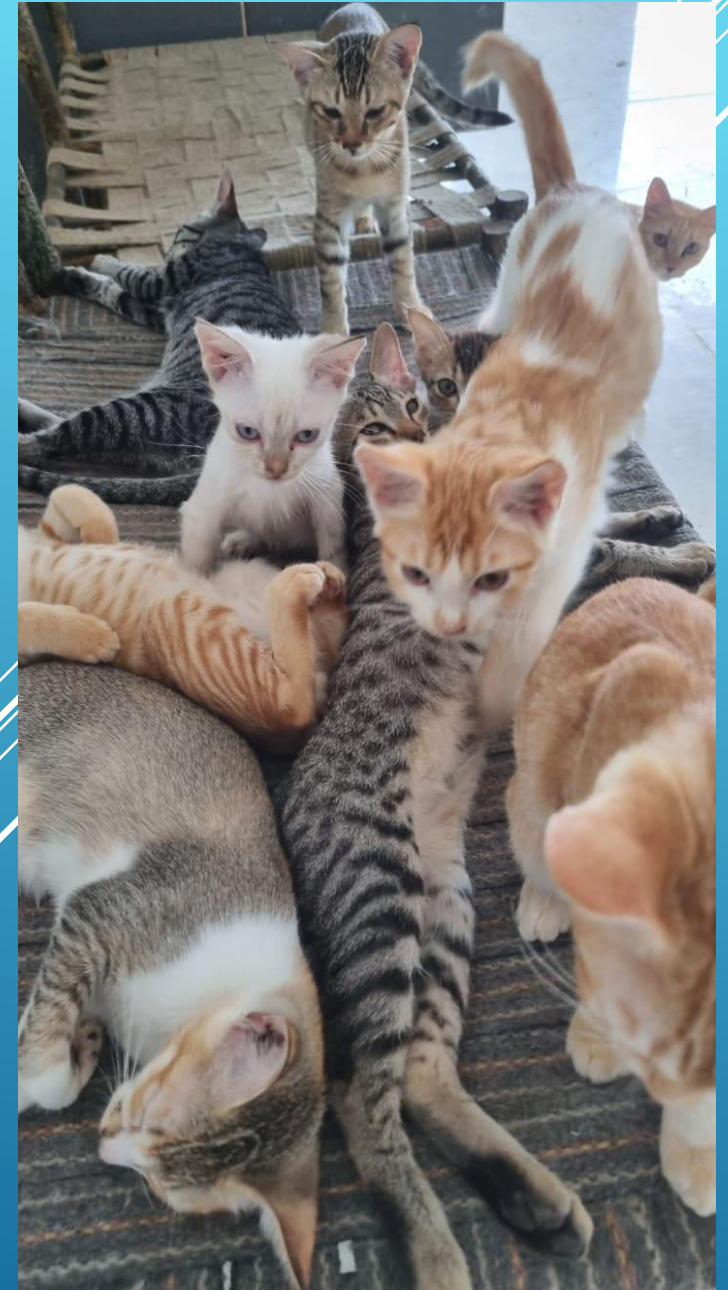




STRAY LOVE

ABOUT US

- ▶ Stray love is a Shelter we Run in Moinabad situated in outskirts of Hyderabad.
- ▶ Mrs. Ashwini Reddy along with Mr. Sabir Hussain And Mr. Baji khan started this Animal shelter during the First Lockdown period as many animals collapsed on roads without food and water.
- ▶ Our place is a one and half Acre land with proper infrastructure and houses more than 100 abandoned and helpless animals.
- ▶ We provide daily food on time to these beautiful souls twice daily.
We get them regular check-ups done thro jubileehills.
- ▶ Proper medication and vaccinations are provided to them regularly.
- ▶ We got more than 50 dogs and 15 CATS spayed (Family planning operation) Mostly through Bluecross and few from other private hospitals.
- ▶ The entire expenditure is taken care by MrsAshwini reddy along with Mr. Sabir Hussain And Mr. Baji khan and we never went for donations.
- ▶ Mr Arvind has been very helpful to us in providing them a proper infrastructure.
- ▶ Mr. Sabir Hussain And Mr. Baji khan take care of the place and manage the workers and see to that the animals are kept in proper protocol guided by Animal welfare dept.
- ▶ Regular sanitation and cleanness is maintained .

LOCKDOWN DEHYDRATED CASES



Lockdown was a Great Tragedy to Thousands of stray Animals.

As there were no people for months on roads Many Puppies died on roads without Food And Water.

Thanks to Mr. Sajjanar Sir That With Special Police Permission We Could Pick Up Tens of Puppies from Streets And Had to Keep them on Medication and Saline for Many days so that they could recover from Weakness and Dehydration.

Now after many pups recovered we shifted them to our shelter and now they are leading a healthy life.

CRITICAL RESCUES



We Rescued "PLUTO" from Ameenpur Area where we found her critically injured after a boulder fell on her hand and cut it off when a plot cleaning was going on by a Jcb.

We rushed her to hospital the Doctor tried a lot to save her hand but it was totally cut off so they had to remove it in the Surgery.

After the surgery we moved her to our shelter and since then we are taking care of her and she has now turned out to be a very beautiful and active dog.

CRITICAL RESCUES



We Rescued "Ronnie" From a Garbage dump where he was shivering in Pain And Irritation as he had a severe injury on his Right ear.

By the time we rescued him half of his ear was eaten by Maggots and we literally removed about 30 maggots from his wound.

Had it been delay in his treatment the maggots would have entered his head and started eating his brain.

After the treatment we have kept him in our shelter and now he is having a peaceful healthy life after so much Pain he had gone through.

CRITICAL RESCUE



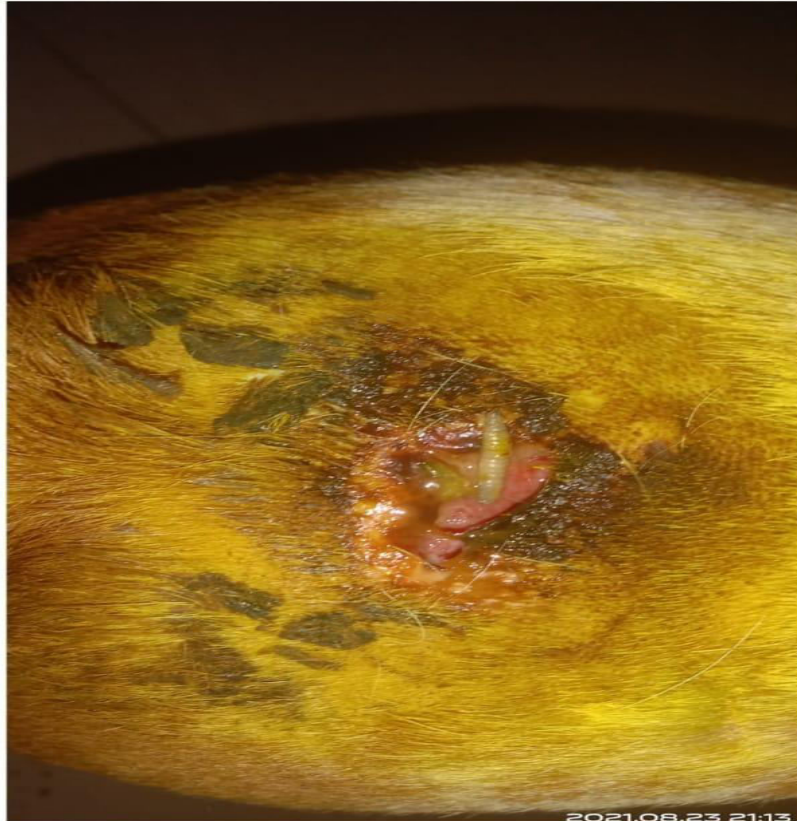
This dog "Chotu" was Rescued from Nallagandalla Area. There was barely any skin in his back part and his flesh was exposed.

His Anal area also had severe injuries and due to long time no treatment he has internal Anal infection also.

It really took us lot of time and patience to get him healed.

CRITICAL RESCUE



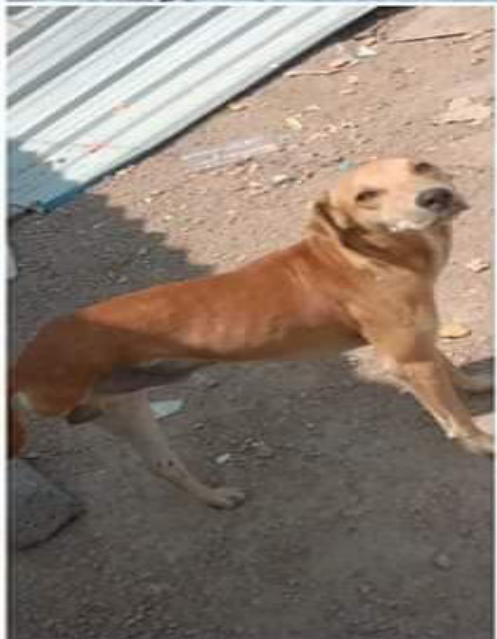
This Female Puppy "Snow"

had almost a 3" Area
eaten by maggots.

If at all now treated in time
the Maggots would have
entered her stomach and
Kidneys Part.

After over a month
Treatment and daily
medications she recovered
and the wound healed
totally.

Now she enjoys a Blessed
pain free life in our shelter
with other dogs and cats
who share same horrific
experiences in their past.

CRITICAL RESCUE



We Found "Hero" at Movie towers Area and was in almost unconscious state and very weak with his right leg very severely injured.

There was lot of blood loss and Doctors tried their best to restore his right leg but couldn't save it and it had to be removed completely.

After the successful Surgery today he leads a very Active life in our shelter happily with his three legs.

CRITICAL RESCUE



This female Puppy “Jupiter” Had Kennel Distemper.
A very serious and deadly virus in Dogs.

When we rescued her she could hardly see anything as her eyes were attached with the puss and she could hardly breath. She was underweight almost 3 kgs compared to her Age.

With proper love and care and very excellent treatment we could save her by God grace.

Now she lives a very healthy life after her long time battle with the Deadly virus in a special area in our shelter where other dogs are strictly not allowed.

RESCUE



This beautiful boy "Milu" was found in the parking pit In Aparna Grande Nallagandalla.

He was hardly Days old boy who fell into the pit and after many days we rescued him.

He was very dehydrated and was in very bad state and after proper care and love he turned out to be so beautiful Cat today.

Along with other Rescued cats he lives with us in our shelter.

Rescued and Abandoned Cats



There are about 50 Rescued and Abandoned cats in our shelter.

We have got them potty trained to maintain hygiene and avoid contagious infections.

We give them proper vaccinations and medication.

We provide them with well branded food and also the water given to them is R.O. Purified water as there are few Persian breed cats in them who are very sensitive.

Most of them are Indian breed cats.

CRITICAL RESCUE



This Two months old puppy “Jigar” was hit by a vehicle on road and his back two legs got Paralysed.

We rescued him in this stage and gave him Medication and good healthy food for recovery.

Now he rests in our shelter Happily.

FIRST AID ON STREETS



We have been providing basic First Aid And Dressings to Many Stray dogs , Cows And many other Animals who have minor injuries.

We see to that we do Dressing to them regularly until the wound is recovered and provide them with basic medication like pain killers and Antibiotics so that the infection dose not worsen.

NUTRITIOUS FEEDING



We Provide Healthy And Nutritious Food for over Hundred Animals Twice Daily.

We give them proper cooked food and keep them on Healthy Diet.
